‘While Paul teaches that a believer in a mixed marriage should stay within it, he recognises however that the unbeliever may decide to leave. If so, the Christian should not feel bound to fight to the bitter end. ‘God has called us to live in peace’ and sometimes, reluctantly, peace is best served by a sad, quiet acceptance of the determination of the departing husband or wife.’
