Who are the 'princes' and 'human beings' in your life who you sometimes turn to before the LORD?

## Why does the Psalmist follow up v5 with v6-10? What are the characteristics of the LORD that stand out in v6-10? Chat about all the contrasts you can find in this Psalm between the 'princes' of this world and the God of heaven... Where can you see Jesus in this Psalm? Turn your conversation to prayer and to praise... Meditate on the words of Jesus below...
