THE GLORIOUS ONE DENIED

John 17v1: After Jesus said this, he looked toward heaven and prayed: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify your Son, that your Son may glorify you.



- 1) Peter In Denial

V15-16: Simon Peter and another disciple were following Jesus. Because this disciple was known to the high priest, he went with Jesus into the high priest's courtyard, 16 but Peter had to wait outside at the door. The other disciple, who was known to the high priest, came back, spoke to the servant girl on duty there and brought Peter in.

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V17: "You aren't one of this man's disciples too, are you?" she asked Peter.

V11: Jesus commanded Peter, "Put your sword away! Shall I not drink the cup the Father has given me?"

2) Authorities — In the Dark



3) Jesus – In Control


13v38: Then Jesus answered, "Will you really lay down your life for me? Very truly I tell you, **before the rooster crows**, you will disown me three times!
