GETTING STARTED

1) A FEAR OF REJECTION (v1-9)

Talk about Moses mindset in v1 and why he feels like that... (see also Ch 2v14)

Our commission may be different to Moses but in what ways might we respond like he did?

Why does God give Moses 3 signs to perform?

2) A LACK OF GIFTING (v10-12)

Chat about Moses’ next excuse as well as God’s response...

Is the promise of help valid for us?

Chat about gifting and willingness in the context of evangelism

3) ANYONE BUT ME! (v13-17)

Why does God respond differently this time?

What do we learn about anger mingled with mercy?

4) A STRANGE SCENE (v24-26)

What's the main issue going on here? (Don't get too distracted with the side issues!)

Why does God want us to know about this episode?

From what we see in this passage in what ways is Jesus a 'better' Moses?

Meditate on the words of Jesus below...

Luke 22v42: "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done."
