• God's determination to deliver his people (6:1-8)

Moses says to God (!!!) that "you have not rescued your people at all" (5:23). Everything has been worse, says Moses, since he went and spoke to Pharaoh. But God does not give Moses a straight answer. What does he do instead?

He tells Moses his name (v2). In most Bibles, this is written with the unusual *small capital letters*, like this: the LORD. But that's much more than just a name: it's a name with lots of meaning included. Listen to the talk about this. You might want to write a few notes about what "the LORD" means:
