GETTING STARTED

1) A MIGHTY JUDGEMENT

What is the 10th plague and how is it different from the others?

What do we need to learn from hard-hearted Pharaoh? See also Rom 2v4-6...

How should that reality move us to pray for our world?

2) A SACRIFICIAL LAMB

What 2 things are Israel rescued from in Chapter 12? Why are both necessary?

How does God accomplish these rescues and what role does the Passover lamb play?

In what ways is the Passover lamb just a shadowy outline of the true 'lamb of God'?

3) A RESCUE TO REMEMBER

What must Israel do to remember these events?

What **must we do** (see Mark 14v12 / Luke 22v14-20) and **what else can we do** to remember the greater rescue of Jesus?

Meditate on the words of Jesus below...

Luke 22v19: And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me."
