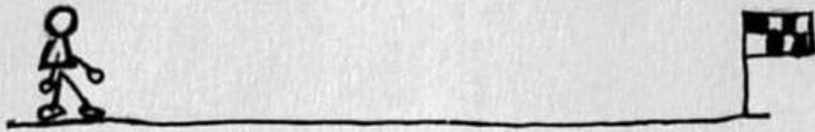

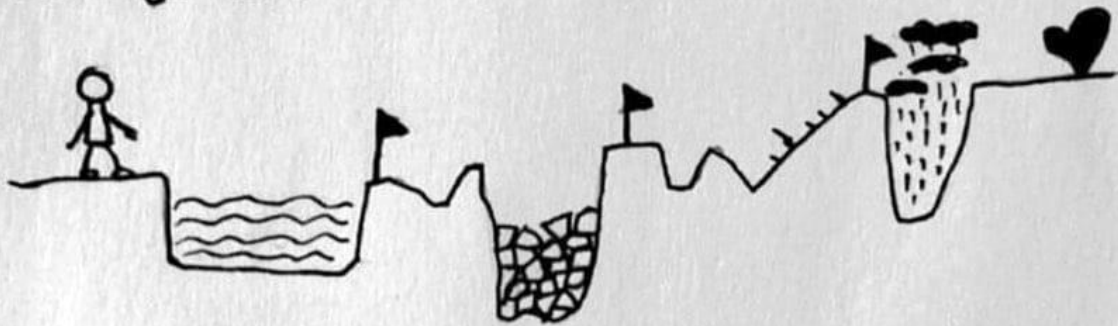
# 1) God leads the way

**V17-18:** When Pharaoh let the people go, God did not lead them on the road through the Philistine country, though that was shorter. For God said, “If they face war, they might change their minds and return to Egypt.” <sup>18</sup> So God led the people around by the desert road toward the Red Sea.

# 1) God leads the way

**V5:** When the king of Egypt was told that the people had fled, Pharaoh and his officials changed their minds about them and said, “What have we done?” We have let the Israelites go and have lost their services!”







# 1) God leads the way

**V11:** They said to Moses, “Was it because there were no graves in Egypt that you brought us to the desert to die? What have you done to us by bringing us out of Egypt?”

**V12:** Didn't we say to you in Egypt, 'Leave us alone; let us serve the Egyptians'? It would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the desert!”

**V13:** Moses answered the people, “Do not be afraid. Stand firm and you will see the deliverance the LORD will bring you today. The Egyptians you see today you will never see again.



# 1) God leads the way

**V14:** The LORD will fight for you; you need only to be still.”

**V16:** Raise your staff and stretch out your hand over the sea to divide the water so that the Israelites can go through the sea on dry ground.

**V26:** Then the LORD said to Moses,  
“Stretch out your hand over the sea so  
that the waters may flow back over the  
Egyptians and their chariots and  
horsemen.”

## Colossians 2v13-15:

When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, <sup>14</sup> having canceled the charge of our legal indebtedness, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross. <sup>15</sup> And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.
