

Matthew 2v1-12 THE PRAISEWORTHY KING

The promised king...

V1: This is the genealogy of <u>Jesus</u> <u>the Messiah</u>...

V18: This is how the birth of <u>Jesus the</u> <u>Messiah</u> came about: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit.
