#### A Firm Footing...


**V1:** Jude, a servant of Jesus Christ and a brother of James,

To those who have been <u>called</u>, who are <u>loved</u> in God the Father and <u>kept</u> for Jesus Christ:

#### The need to contend...

V4: For certain individuals whose condemnation was written about long ago have secretly slipped in among you. They are ungodly people, who pervert the grace of our God into a license for immorality and deny Jesus Christ our only Sovereign and Lord.

## Why does Jude describe these people in such detail?





**Spot** them at a distance

**Keep** them at a distance

**V5:** Though you already know all this, I want to remind you that the Lord at one time <u>delivered</u> his people out of Egypt, but later <u>destroyed</u> those who did not believe.

Disbelieving Israel

V6: And the angels who did not keep their positions of authority but <u>abandoned</u>
their proper dwelling — these he has kept in darkness, bound with everlasting chains for judgment on the great Day.

The rebellious angels

V7: In a similar way, Sodom and Gomorrah and the surrounding towns gave themselves up to sexual immorality and perversion.

The immoral city

V8: In the very same way, on the strength of their dreams these ungodly people pollute their own bodies, reject authority and heap abuse on celestial beings.

#### 3) They promise life but deliver death

V12-13: These people are **blemishes** at your love feasts, eating with you without the slightest qualm—shepherds who feed only themselves. They are **clouds** without rain, blown along by the wind; autumn trees, without fruit and uprooted—twice dead. 13 They are wild waves of the sea, foaming up their shame; wandering stars, for whom blackest darkness has been reserved forever.
