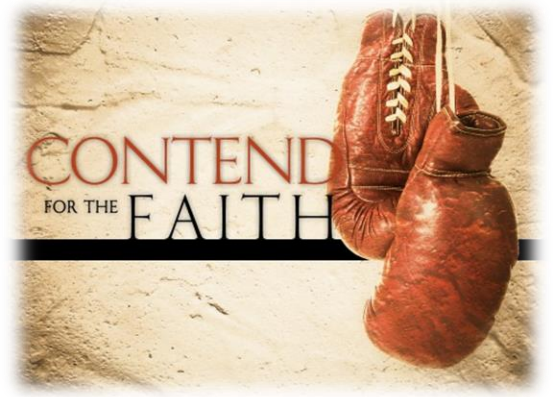




# LISTEN UP!

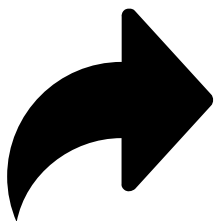
