### **Proverbs 16v18:** Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall.

**V36:** Then Jesus went with his disciples to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to them, "Sit here while I go over there and pray."





## **V37:** He took Peter and the two sons of Zebedee along with him, and he began to be <u>sorrowful</u> and <u>troubled</u>.





# **V38:** Then he said to them, 'My soul is overwhelmed with <u>sorrow</u> to the point of death.'
