



# LISTEN UP!

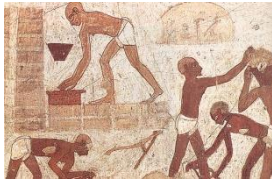
Exodus 20:4-7 – “True worship of the true God”

**STEP 1** – Find the book of **Exodus** in your Bibles ...

**STEP 2** – Follow in the Bible and **listen up!**

- Exodus 20 has lots of DON'Ts – things that we must not do – but it starts by saying something wonderful that God has done. See what that is in verse 2:

“I am the L \_ \_ \_ Y \_ \_ \_ G \_ \_ ,  
 who brought you out of E \_ \_ \_ \_ ,



out of the L \_ \_ \_ of S \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ “

Now that God has done this for the Israelites, he sets some rules for them to live by – rules that will be *for their own good*. What are the first three (we looked at the first one last week)?

“You shall have N \_ \_ O \_ \_ \_ \_ G \_ \_ \_ \_” (verse 3)

“You shall not make for yourself an I \_ \_ \_ \_ \_” (verse 4)

“You shall not M \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ the N \_ \_ \_ of the LORD your God” (verse 7)

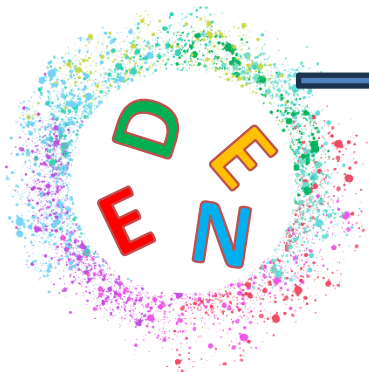

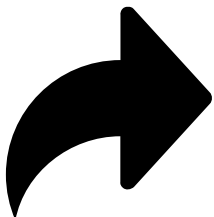
